

QUICK RELEASE HALTER TIE KNOT



Horse's Butt



Horse's Nose



If you use a rope halter and have ever needed to untie it quickly, here's the knot for you!

Tie the usual knot through the tie loop. The end of the rope should point toward the horse's butt.

Next loosen the knot slightly and push the tail of the rope back through the knot, following alongside Part A. Toward the horse's nose

Last part, pull a bit of the end through the knot, about 3 inches, and push down on the knot to secure it. Now the tail will be pointing to the horse's nose.

A simple tug on the end will release the knot fully. As long as you push down on the knot and create some friction/tension on it, it will hold firmly.
